Goals/aims:

In the last two weeks year seven students have been presented with major representatives of various genres taken from English literature. The selected texts are supposed to arouse interest in and fascination for reading. Furthermore the activity of reading has been interwoven with the application of speaking, writing and listening abilities.

In doing so the students were confronted with contextual analysis (“The Landlady”), age-related problems (“Little Johnny`s final letter” and “What happened to Lulu”) as well as serious moral dilemmas (Dr. Jekyll and Mr. Hyde). Moreover, unusual experiences of sentimental feelings and moods (“Stopping by woods” and “Stop all the clocks”) were explored.
